

Out of the studio exhibition of art

Local visual artists Kerrie Warren and Dragi Jankovic will join forces for a powerful exhibition at the West Gippsland Arts Centre opening on Thursday at 6.30pm.

The exhibition, "Out of the Studio", is an exhibition of paintings and ceramics which is currently open to the public on weekdays until October 29.

Both artists work professionally from studios in Gippsland and look forward to collaborating on the exhibition.

Kerrie is an abstract expressionist painter from Crossover. Her style of work is also referred to as "action painting".

Kerrie's aim is to bypass self-censoring thought and allow other doors to open.

Her large works on canvas are bold, dynamic and textural, emanating a strong sense of movement and energy.

After recent and successful exhibitions in New York, Singapore, China and Italy, Kerrie looks forward to exhibiting latest works in Warragul.

Dragi is a ceramic artist who retired from teaching ceramics in 2002 to focus on his works.

Dragi allowed a journey to Japan to influence his work and thus create a deeper understanding between him and the forms and vessels he creates.

Dragi's forms are complex but graceful, fragile yet strong. Extreme precision is required on all accounts. Each piece is meticulously designed on the mental plane prior to physical creation; many of the techniques and glazes have been developed over months and years to be absolutely unique to this artist.
